

### AIM:


All children to be readers by the end of Key Stage One



### **METHOD:**

High quality, systematic teaching of phonics – the building blocks of reading

40,000 children will leave primary school with a reading age of below 7 years old



### Read, Write Inc.

Read Write Inc. is an inclusive literacy programme for all children in Foundation Stage to Year 4.



It is also suitable for children in older year groups who have significant learning difficulties, including specific literacy problems.

# What is high quality phonics work?


- Correspondences between phonemes and graphemes
- Taught in a clearly defined sequence



- Oral blending reading
- Segmentation writing
- 'Sound Talk' or 'Fred Talk'
- Pure sounds





### How can you help?



- Praise the children if they spot a sound e.g.
   My name begins with mmmmmm
- Build onto their learning by giving examples of other words that have that sound
- Use the world around them to hunt for sounds or practice some Fred Talk

The Phonics Screening Check (otherwise known as the Phonics Screening Test or simply Phonics Test) is a short assessment given to children as part of the National Curriculum.

The test seeks to check whether children have learned to decode words using phonics to a required level.

The Phonics Test is compulsory in all state schools (including academies and Free schools) and is given to pupils at the end of Year 1.
